

**Rock Creek Council 2797 High School Scholarship 2017 – 2018
APPLICATION CHECKLIST**

Eligibility:

An applicant must be an 8th grade child entering a Catholic High School in the Archdiocese of DC. Children of **Rock Creek Council** members in good standing will be given either a 5 point preference or for **3rd degree INSURANCE member**, given a 10 point preference. Children of deceased members in good standing at the time of their death are also eligible. An insurance member either owns a KC insurance policy or a KC annuity.

Non-members may apply IF their father is eligible and willing to join Rock Creek Council. Scholarships awarded to non-members will be for **one year**, UNLESS the father becomes a 3rd degree INSURANCE member of Rock Creek Council before the time for renewal occurs in the following year. Renewals are NOT automatic, renewal requires:

1. The student must maintain a “B” average (3.0 + on 4.0 scale).
2. The father must be or must **become a 3rd degree INSURANCE member** **
3. Copies of grades and parents participation in council activities are required.
** NOTE: to become an “Insurance” member, one can purchase an annuity (min. \$400.) OR purchase any other KC insurance policy (long term care, whole life, term etc)

All applicants must be accepted and enrolled to attend an accredited Catholic High School in the Archdiocese of Washington. Up to 3 scholarships may be awarded each year and each award is for \$1500. with renewal up to 3 additional years. **Award funds will be sent to the applicant’s high school and used for the payment of tuition only.**

Criteria:

Applications will be judged on the basis of Academic Achievement, personal qualifications, merit, and **involvement in council**, church and community activities.

Checklist:

The application must include materials in the following order:

1. The Application Form
2. Middle School Principal or Student Counselor Evaluation
3. Student’s Academic Grades transcript 7th Grade and first semester 8th grade
4. Additional references, recommendations, information on awards, and information on council, church and community activities (student and parents)

All documentation MUST be received at the same time. Failure to submit all elements at the same time will result in rejection of the application.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read application carefully. Provide information and answer all questions fully.
2. Notify your school authorities of having made application for this scholarship grant. Request that the school principal or counselor fully complete the questionnaire contained in the application. Obtain from your school a complete transcript of your academic grades. The questionnaire and grades record should be placed by the principal or counselor in a sealed envelope **and must be included with your application at the time of filing.** This required information would not be accepted or made part of your application if mailed separately.
3. You may attach personal references or recommendations from your pastor, teachers, employers, coaches, including evidence of awards, (academic, community, church, etc.) that you received and personal accomplishments. However, references, which should be submitted in sealed envelopes, must be included with your application at the time of filing, and will not be accepted or made part of your application if received separately.
4. Each application with attachments **must be received IN ITS ENTIRETY** no later than **JUNE 1, 2017**

Late or incomplete entries will not be eligible. **Mail your completed application, following the guidelines specified above, to:**
